CHAPTER V

CONCLUSION

This section contains conclusions and suggestions regarding the research that has been conducted. Conclusions contain findings related to the formulation of problems and research objectives. While suggestions come from analysis related to the scope of the research.

A. Conclusion

In this thesis, researcher examine the use of sexist language in Instagram comment sections on posts relating to the wedding of Denny Caknan and Bella Bonita. In this study, it can be concluded that sexist language in comments still exists and in various types. The most dominant forms of sexism are jokes and presuppositions, where these comments discriminate more against women. Comments containing insults, gender stereotypes, and insulting body shapes are often conveyed in the form of jokes and commenters' assumptions. The social factor that influenced these comments was the presence of haters who were displeased and dissatisfied with the wedding, leading to sexist comments against the bride. Therefore, the comments were predominantly expressive, expressing their dislike and dissatisfaction by writing derogatory comments and using words that offended the bride.

B. Suggestion

In this chapter, suggestions for future research are presented. Research using field-based research will be more optimal because direct conversations are easier to analyze in depth, including knowing how to speak directly. Another alternative is to do research on popular TikTok videos to see if there is still gender discrimination. Future research is expected to examine similar phenomena but in different locations. This research is expected to increase readers' knowledge about gender sexism in popular phenomena such as those that have been analyzed.
