

ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengkaji pengaturan hukum mengenai pengendalian dan pengawasan peredaran minuman beralkohol berdasarkan Peraturan Daerah Kabupaten Ngawi Nomor 10 Tahun 2012, menganalisis implementasi pengendalian dan pengawasan peredaran minuman beralkohol di Kabupaten Ngawi, serta mengidentifikasi kendala yang dihadapi dalam pelaksanaannya. Metode penelitian yang digunakan adalah yuridis empiris dengan sifat deskriptif. Pendekatan yang digunakan merupakan pendekatan perundang-undangan dan pendekatan sosiologis. Sumber data terdiri atas data primer dan data sekunder. Teknik pengumpulan data dilakukan melalui wawancara, observasi, dan studi kepustakaan. Analisis data dilakukan secara kualitatif menggunakan model interaktif Miles dan Huberman. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa: (1) Perda Kabupaten Ngawi Nomor 10 Tahun 2012 mengatur penggolongan minuman beralkohol berdasarkan kadar etanol dan menetapkan kebijakan tidak ada izin peredaran minuman beralkohol Golongan B dan C di wilayah Kabupaten Ngawi; (2) Implementasi pengendalian dan pengawasan peredaran minuman beralkohol telah berjalan cukup baik melalui patroli rutin, operasi gabungan lintas instansi, serta penegakan sanksi administratif; dan (3) Kendala yang dihadapi meliputi keterbatasan anggaran, masih adanya peredaran ilegal, kepatuhan pelaku usaha yang belum merata, serta kurangnya sosialisasi kepada masyarakat. Penelitian ini menyarankan agar pemerintah daerah meningkatkan alokasi anggaran, memperkuat koordinasi lintas instansi, dan mengintensifkan sosialisasi Perda kepada pelaku usaha dan masyarakat.

ABSTRACT

This study aims to examine the legal regulation of the control and supervision of the circulation of alcoholic beverages based on Ngawi Regency Regional Regulation Number 10 of 2012, to analyze the implementation of the control and supervision of the circulation of alcoholic beverages in Ngawi Regency, and to identify the obstacles encountered in its implementation. The research method employed is empirical juridical with a descriptive nature. The approaches used are the statutory approach and the sociological approach. Data sources consist of primary and secondary data. Data were collected through interviews, observations, and literature study. Data analysis was conducted qualitatively using the interactive model of Miles and Huberman. The results indicate that: (1) Ngawi Regency Regional Regulation Number 10 of 2012 regulates the classification of alcoholic beverages based on ethanol content and establishes a policy of not issuing permits for the circulation of Group B and C alcoholic beverages in Ngawi Regency; (2) The implementation of the control and supervision of the circulation of alcoholic beverages has been running fairly well through routine patrols, joint cross-agency operations, and the enforcement of administrative sanctions; and (3) The obstacles faced include budget limitations, the continued existence of illegal circulation, uneven compliance among business operators, and insufficient socialization to the public. This study recommends that the regional government increase budget allocation, strengthen cross-agency coordination, and intensify the socialization of the Regional Regulation to business operators and the wider community.
